

Dear Member

On behalf of the committee and all members of the Capricornia Budgerigar Society Inc., I wish you all the best for 2014. It is hard to believe that almost 2 months are gone and our Annual Show is fast approaching. The Zone Show will be held in Townsville with the representative team going to Adelaide for the ANBC Championship Show.

Excellent prize money has again been allocated to our shows. The Schedule for our Annual Show is included in this newsletter. Note that the Classes have been extended to include the new ANBC classes to be introduced at the 2013 ANBC Show in Toowoomba. There is also a class for JUVELINE birds, ie for 2014 (black rings) birds that have broken their cap. What a great opportunity to give these birds a day out and train them for future shows. There may be a National winner for 2015 amongst them. The DERBY winners will be judged at this Show and will share over \$100 in prizemoney. All members who purchased their rings from Scott have birds eligible for this prize as the first 10 rings purchased are designated as Derby rings!!

The Club has organised another aviary visit on course to the Brisbane BRASEA Auction. The trips in the last 2 years have gained an excellent response from those who attended. It would be great if more people could attend this year. The aviary visits will be educational and a highlight.

You will notice in the Calendar of events that there are some excellent lectures scheduled for these meetings. Add to that the chance to win \$15-00 in the Table Show. The birds get good training and provide excellent discussion topics as they are analysed and discussed after the judging. The lecture at the February Meeting was well received by the good number of members in attendance.



Invitations have been sent to non-CBS breeders to nominate birds for our Annual Auction, with more top line breeders requesting to be a part of this year's event. All CLUB members may enter up to 6 birds with another 2 if attending on the day. A letter is enclosed in this mail-out. Put those best culls aside for this great event. Nominate before May 09! The sooner nominations are received the sooner the catalogue can be distributed. Note that the Auction will be held on July 06. Keep that date free

Congratulations to winners at recent Shows, especially to John Agnew on his first ever Grand Champion win at the Breeders Show. The Nutley family went one better than in 2012 where they won the Beginner BOY by winning both the Bird of the Year and Beginner BOY for 2013 last November. Well done!

- Annual Show: Nest feather entries must be rung with 2014 rings (black in colour), whilst the Young Birds must be green 2013 rung birds.



Dear Member

Following the great success of our 2013 Winter Auction, our Club is again conducting a major Auction on **July 06**, 2 weeks after the Nationals in Adelaide. Birds from top southern breeders and exhibitors as well as from local Zone fanciers will be assembled. It is anticipated that many fanciers from Cairns to the Gold Coast will be attending, as well as several well known inter-state exhibitors. The venue for this year's auction is the Performing Arts Centre, North R'ton High School, Simpson Street, North Rockhampton. Off-street parking from Simpson Street is available.

It is with great pleasure that we invite you to submit birds for benching at this event. It is expected that birds offered will be no more than 2 years of age (rung 20012/13/14), and that freighting to and from Rockhampton will be organised and paid for by you. However, care of the birds, show cages, benching, etc., will be fully organised by the Capricornia Budgerigar Society Inc. (CBS Inc.). The CBS Inc. will retain a 10% commission on the selling price. An entry fee of \$1 per bird also applies.

As part of our advertising we wish to place the catalogue on our new Club web site to generate interest. It would be appreciated if you could **provide details on the attached proforma and return this to me by Friday May 09**. This should ensure that the catalogue goes on the web and can be posted to the fanciers in many Queensland Clubs by the end of May. A photo of a nominated bird or birds would be appreciated and may be included in the catalogue. **Late entries** will go onto a waiting list as the number of lots offered in this auction is capped!

It would be appreciated if you could advise me as soon as possible if you are able to provide **up to SIX birds**. For this year, an **extra 2 birds can be added** to this number if you will be attending on the Auction day. If you are unable to supply birds then these can be re-allocated as we are limiting the lots to approx 200 to 240 and the demand for lots in this event is strong. Also if a bird or birds need to be scratched then there is no guarantee that a replacement bird will be accepted.

We have also organised a 'Pre-Auction' Meal and 'get-together' on the Saturday evening at the Berserker Tavern, Dean Street Street, North Rockhampton. This has been well patronised in previous years. It is an enjoyable function and a great opportunity to have a good feed and a great chat to many of the top local and visiting breeders. It's a chance to learn a few trade secrets as well as get some inside information from the breeders of some of the birds being auctioned the next day.

Thank you for your consideration and support. I look forward to your reply and a profitable and successful auction.
