A Budgie Good Adventure

During August a few of the club members travelled to Newcastle for the Newcastle Budgerigar Club's auction/show weekend held at the Wallsend community hall. A couple of us have been travelling to this event for a number of years now occasionally accompanied by other members. It is without a doubt an excellent weekend, not only for the comradery experienced but also for the excellent birds viewed and sometimes bought.

Over the years Scott and myself have been the constant at the event. This year Ian travelled with me and we visited Ken Seagrott's aviaries at Gilgai on the way down. Most club members would know Ken from his attendance at our annual auction. Although not considered one of the so called "in breeders" I consider Ken to have very good birds, in fact a Grey Green of his was the sire of my National winning Grey. He has also won several Nationals as well as many high placings and many of his birds are behind many other breeders winners.

At Newcastle we visited the aviaries of Garry Gazzard, Wally Capper, Alan and Chris Druery, Mark and Rebecca Fellows as well as Darren and Karen Peters. We both left drooling at the excellent quality of bird after bird at these establishments. We saw and learnt many great tips to help our own bird husbandry methods.

I don't think there is another area in Australia where there is so many top breeders in such close proximity to one another and spurring each other on to greater heights. Of the above listed breeders Garry is probably the most widely acclaimed, but the area also has a legend of budgerigar breeding in Alan Reid and another champion breeder in Barry and Maree Wise. Ernie Wise is also one of their members but is further away at Tamworth, and is also well known to our members from his attendance at our auctions.

Just below this level is a myriad of top class breeders such as Cliff Cameron, Brian Walters, Geoff O'Conner, Greg Parker, Jupp and Scheerer, Paul and Maree McCusker, Ken Yorke, Michael Bannister and Ingham and Langdon. There is also another dozen or so less well known but still very good breeders producing very good birds. There are many more breeders in the area whose names I do not know but are still influential to their club environment.

I would highly recommend this weekend to our members and I am happy to discuss these trips with our members as I am sure Scott and Ian would be as well. I believe next year they are splitting the auction still 2nd weekend in August and the show now late November. From our viewpoint it may not be as good but on the upside it gives us more time to visit aviaries. I would highly recommend considering attending this weekend. It does not have to be expensive especially if travel and accommodation is shared.
